Aim of the Workshop is to review progress on analysis of data from AMMA aircraft, SCOUT-AMMA balloons and the M55-Geophysica focused on the UT and LS over West Africa. A series of opening presentations on the 7th will be followed on the 8th by presentations on the analysis of these datasets related to the following topics:

A. Vertical and long-range transport of trace gases and aerosols, including modelling of convection (MCS) and impact on UT/LS composition

B. Aerosols, clouds and water vapour in the UT/LS

This will include discussion about the strategy for future work, papers in preparation, possible overview papers, journal special sections, etc.
